

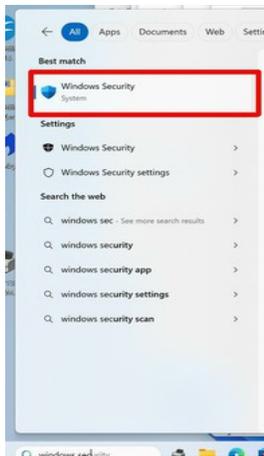
## HOW TO CREATE A FIREWALL RULE FOR GZDOOM.EXE

(You will want to make a note as to where the Doom Game is installed, for later reference.)

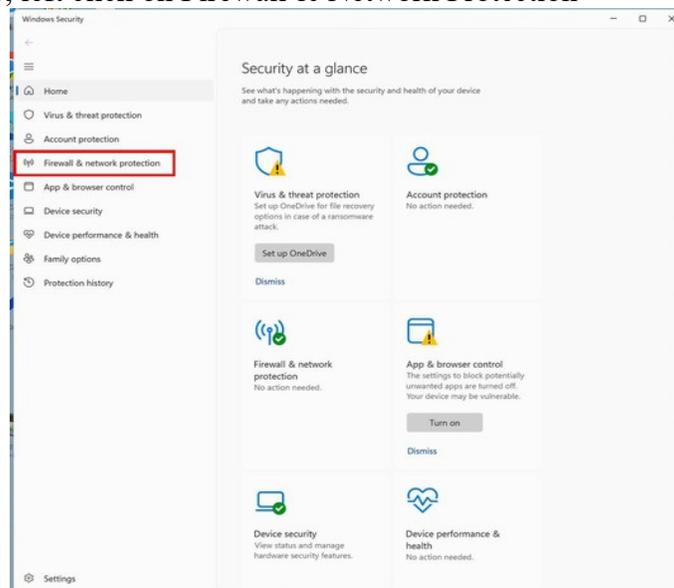
1. Type into the Search textbox “Windows Security” (without the quotation marks)



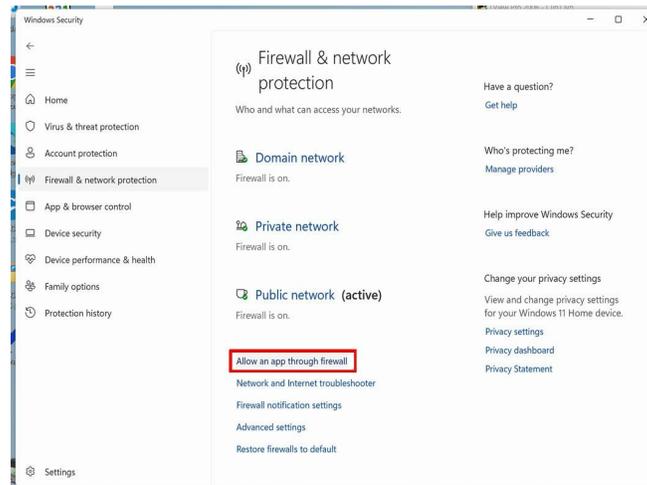
2. In the menu that pops up, left click on it



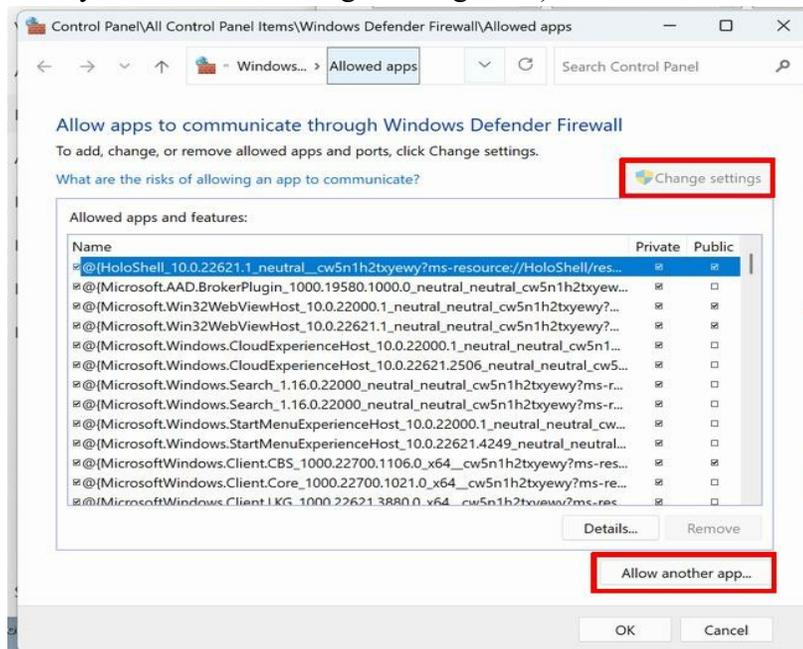
3. In this window, left click on Firewall & Network Protection



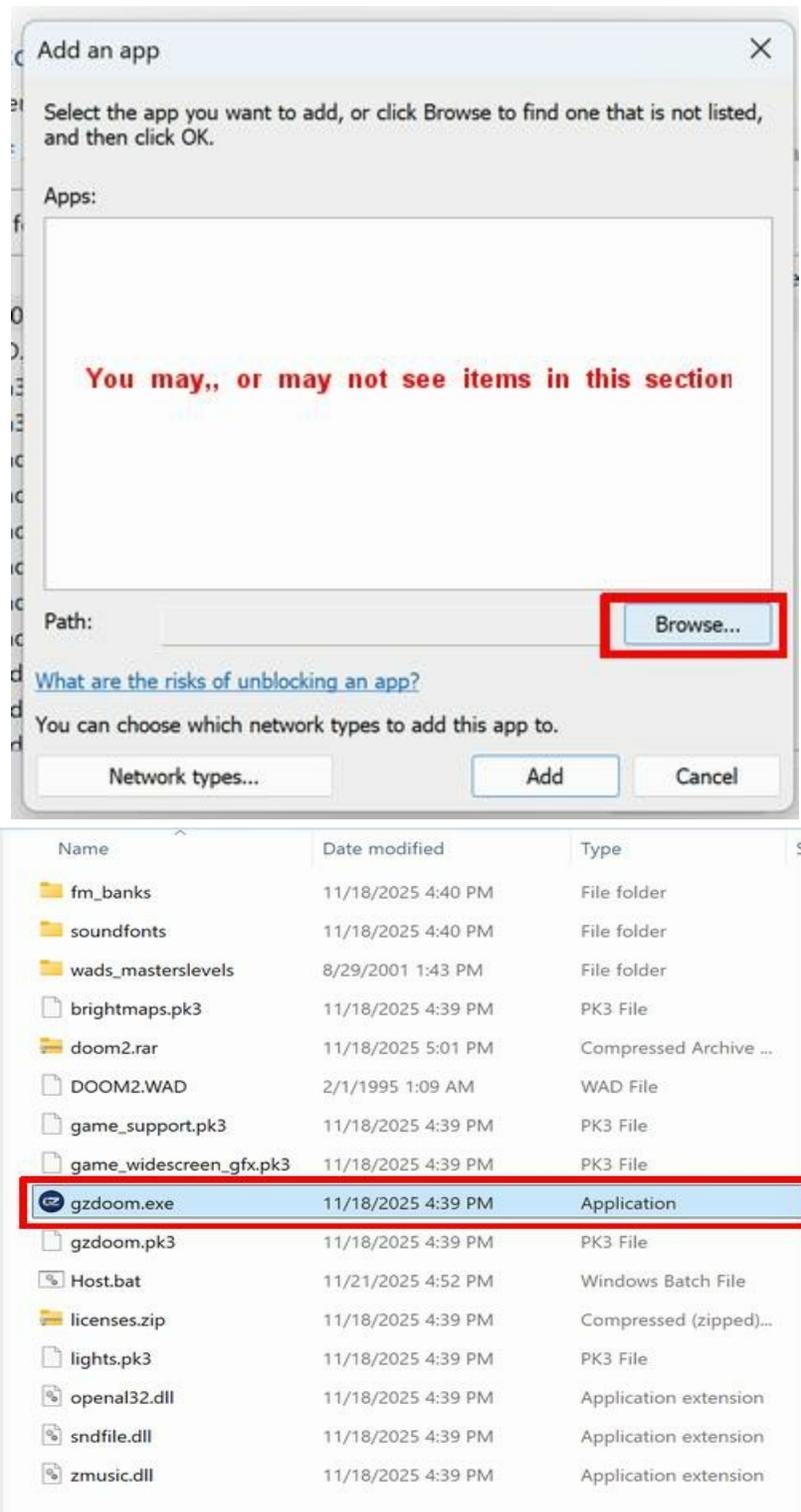
4. Left click on “Allow an app through firewall”.



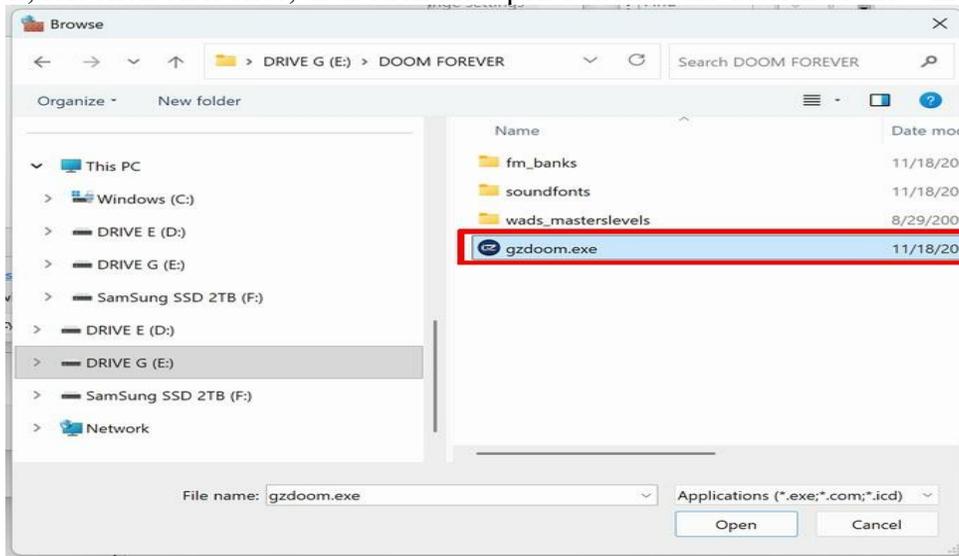
5. In this next image, click on Allow an app through firewall.  
(You may need to click Change Settings first)



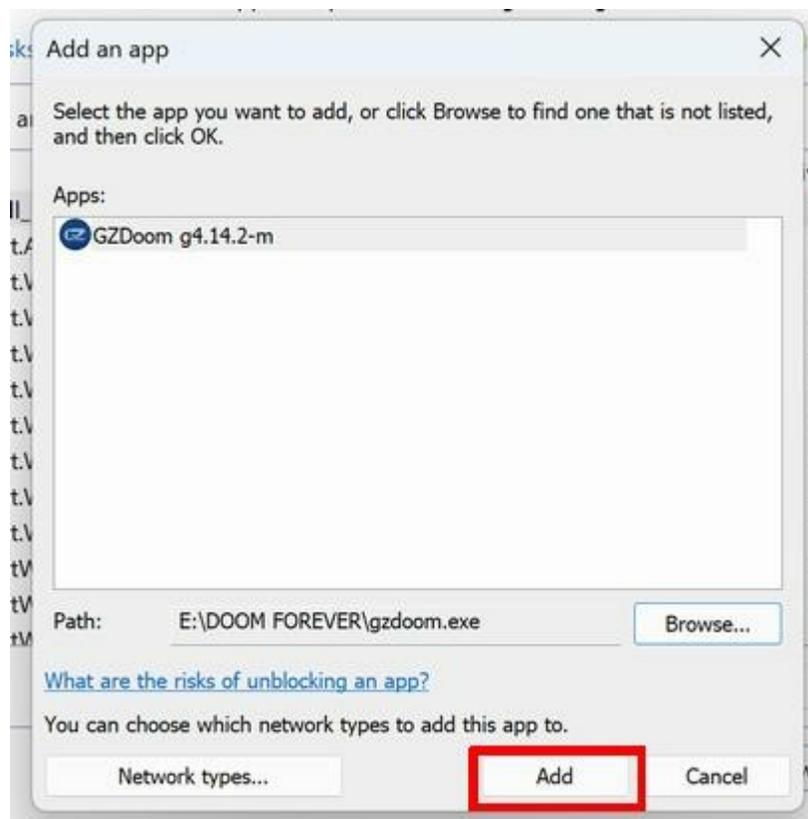
6. In this window, we are going to go find the **gzdoom.exe** program, and add it to the Apps section, so go click on the BROWSE button. A File Explorer window will popup. You want to navigate to where your Doom Game is installed..



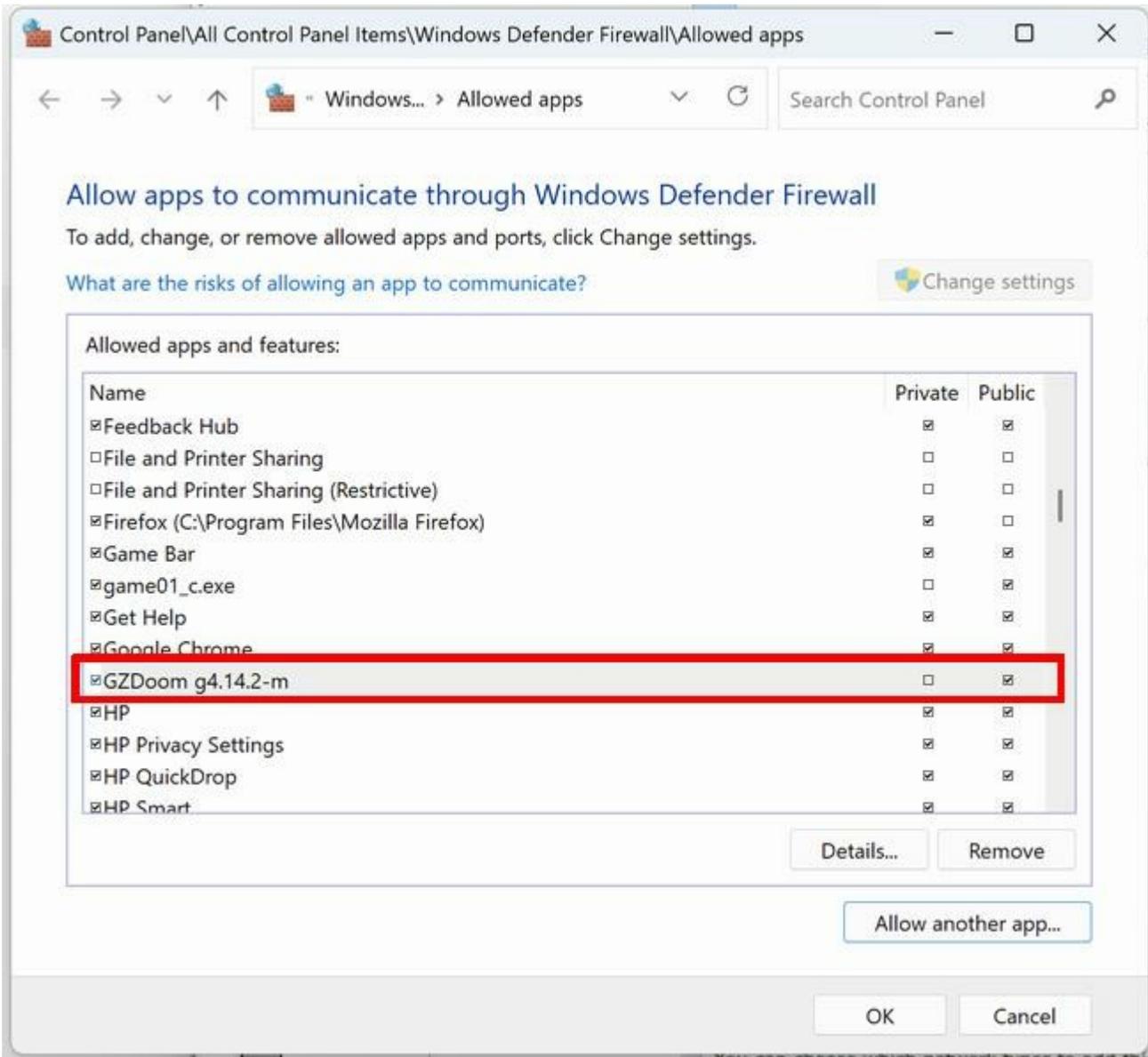
My gzdoom.exe is located in [E:/DOOM FOREVER](#). Yours is probably located somewhere else, but after you find it, left click on it once, then click the Open button at the bottom of the window.



Once you do this, the game will be added to the Apps list, and you want to click the ADD button



Once you click the ADD button, we go back to this window, and you see that it is added to the Name column



Now you can click the OK button, and we are done.
